



**EL MACERO CLASSIC**

**Notice to Players**

(This information supplements the Rules of Golf, effective January 2023 and the 2024 NCAA Hard Card)

**Pace of Play:** Playing time today is 4 hours and 58 minutes – Maximum Time. See Pace of Play Guidelines – Stay Up with the Group in Front of You.

**Tee Markers:** All play will be from the **BLUE** Tee Markers, wherever they are situated.

**Scorecard:** The El Macero CC scorecard and/or yardage book are unofficial and have no status in the competition.

**One Ball Rule:** The Model Local Rule G-4 is in effect.

**Out of Bounds:** Defined by the inside edges at ground level of white stakes, perimeter fences, perimeter rock or cement walls, cement borders that separate back yards from the golf course, and white ground lines connecting OB stakes or fence posts. Additionally:

- a. Maintenance shed to the right of **Hole #3**;
- b. On **Hole #5** by curb behind putting green;
- c. By the course-side edge of paved perimeter and interior public roads or its curbing;
- d. A ball coming to rest beyond perimeter and interior public roads is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.

**Obstructions:** Includes all artificially surfaced roads and paths. Railroad ties and rock formations adjacent to cart paths are treated as part of the cart path. Players may take relief under Rule 16.1a. Additionally:

- a. An exposed bunker liner may be treated as ground under repair, but interference does not exist if the liner interferes only with the player's stance.

**Protection of Young Trees:** Young trees identified by stakes are no play zones. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f (Model Local Rule E-10).

**Integral Objects:** Unmaintained cart paths on the course are integral objects. Free relief is not available.

**No Play Zones:** Flower beds on the course are no play zones that are treated as abnormal course conditions. Free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f (Model Local Rule E-8.1).

**Aeration Holes:** The Local Rule as prescribed by Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect (Model Local Rule E-4).

**Practice Area Between Holes #1 and #10:** The short game area between Holes #1 and #10 is a designated practice area on the course. The chipping green itself is a Wrong Green and Rule 13.1f applies.

**Advice:** A player may accept advice from his team's designated advice givers only (teammates are not partners).

**Scoring:** A scorecard is treated as officially returned once the player has left the scoring area.
